Reference is made to your application dated November 10, 1961, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the production from the Basin-Dakota Pool and undesignated Gallup pool on your Jicarilla Apache Lease, located in Section 22, Township 25 North, Range 4 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, without separately metering the production from each pool.
