Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application, dated March 5, 1962, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the production from the Terry-Blinbry, Hare and Drinkard Pools on your Taylor Glenn Lease located in Sections 3 and 4, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPN, Lea County, New Mexico.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the Terry-Blinbry and Hare production without measurement and to commingle said commingled production with the Drinkard production on the above-described Taylor Glenn Lease, after separately measuring the production from the Drinkard Pool; provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
