Reference is made to your application, dated June 28, 1962, for an amendment to Administrative Order PC-82, dated May 11, 1962, which authorized Texaco Inc. to commingle the production from the North Justis Tubb-Drinkard and North Justis-Devonian Pools underlying your G. L. Erwin "a" Lease, comprising the SW/4 of Section 35, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that you now wish to include the North Justis-Blinebry production from this lease in the commingling tank battery inasmuch as the Blinebry production has been reclassified from sour to intermediate sweet. We further understand that you will separately meter the production from the North Justis Tubb-Drinkard and North Justis-Devonian Pools and determine the Blinebry production by means of the subtraction method.

Administrative Order PC-82 is hereby amended to include the North Justis-Blinebry Pool in the previously authorized installation.
