Gentlemen:

Cabot Corporation hereby requests an amendment to Administrative Orders PC-102 and CTB-91 to permit commingling in common facilities of oil produced from the Wolfcamp formation in Cabot's John R. Thompson lease in Section 23, Township 11 South, Range 33 East, Lea County. Prior exception has been granted this lease for commingling production from the Upper Penn formation under the above Administrative Orders.


Oil produced from the John R. Thompson lease will be commingled with Wolfcamp production from Cabot's Humble-State and State of New Mexico "L" leases and Upper Penn production from Cabot's State of New Mexico "M" lease into a central tank battery on the Humble-State lease.

There will be no loss of gravities or values of oil produced and commingled.

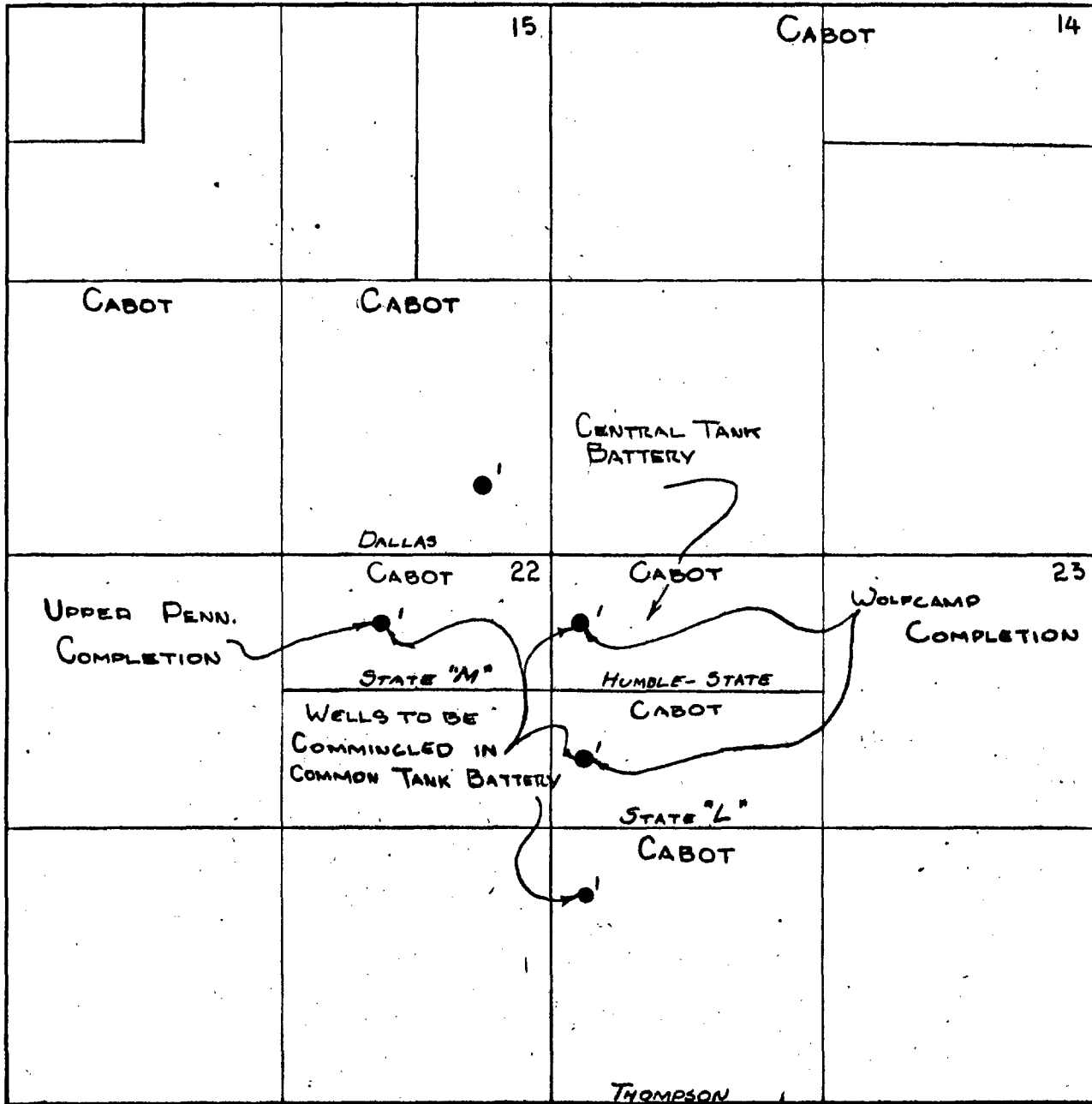
Attached is a schematic diagram of the proposed installation and a plat showing leases and wells involved.

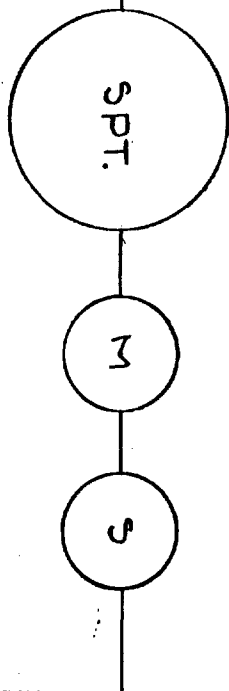

SECTION \_\_\_\_\_ TOWNSHIP 11S RANGE 33E COUNTY LEA STATE N. MEXICO

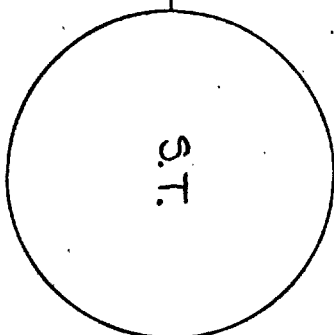
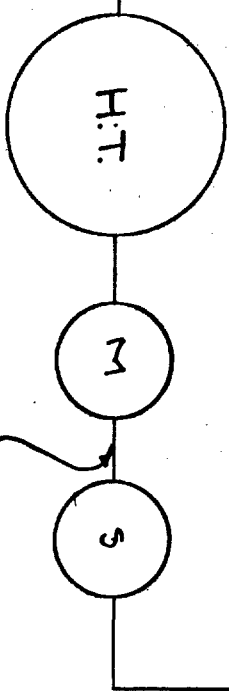


LOCATION PLAT
