Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated February 4, 1963, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the production from the Vacuum-Drinkard and Vacuum-Abo pools on your State of New Mexico "R" NCT-4 Lease comprising the N/2 NW/4 of Section 7, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from the Vacuum-Drinkard Pool and determining the Vacuum-Abo production by means of the subtraction method.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the provision for non-reset counters on the meters.
