AMENDMENT

Administrative Order PC-137

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated February 24, 1969, wherein you request the amendment of Administrative Order PC-137 which currently authorizes the commingling of Drinkard, Blinebry Oil, Wantz Abo, and Wantz Granite Wash production on your New Mexico "S" State Lease comprising all of Section 2, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests with the exception of one well, your State "S" Well No. 22, which is capable of producing more than top unit allowable from the Blinebry Oil Pool, and is therefore metered. It is our understanding that you now wish to add condensate from the Tubb Gas Pool and the Blinebry Gas Pool to the commingling installation without separate measurement of the production from any pool with the exception of the aforementioned State "S" Well No. 22.

Administrative Order PC-137 is hereby amended to permit the commingling of Drinkard, Blinebry Oil, Wantz Abo, Wantz Granite Wash, Blinebry Gas Pool distillate, and Tubb Gas Pool distillate in a common tank battery, with the provision that your State "S" Well No. 22 will continue to be separately metered and provided further that the wells shall be tested at least once each month in order that an accurate determination of barrels and gravities produced from each pool can be made.
