## Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated May 10, 1963, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the production from the Maljamar (Grayburg-San Andres) and the Baish-Wolfcamp Pools from that portion of the Baish "B" Lease lying outside the participating area of the Maljamar Cooperative Area Unit which comprises the N/2 NE/4 and NE/4 NW/4 of Section 22, Township 17 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Maljamar (Grayburg-San Andres) production and determining the Wolfcamp production by means of the subtraction method. The tank battery for said commingled production will be located in the NE/4 SW/4 of said Section 22.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters.
