Gentlemen:

Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 303b to commingle production from four pools underlying the Baish "B" Lease which consists of the NE/4, the SW/4, the E/2 of NW/4, and the NW/4 of the SE/4 of Section 22, T17S, R32E, and the S/2 of the SE/4 of Section 21, T17S, R32E, Lea County, New Mexico. Wells and pools to be commingled are as follows:

All in Section 22, T17S, R32E, Lea County, New Mexico

In support of this request, we should like to point out that the proposed facility is in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Commission's "Manual For the Installation & Operation of Commingling Facilities", now current, and Rule 303 (b), as follows:

- Ownership of all zones is identical.
- 2. The facility as illustrated on the attached schematic drawing is in substantial compliance with the installations depicted in figures 3 and 4 in the manual. Individual well test facilities are not required in this installation since each well is to be metered separately, with the exception of the marginal Maljamar Pool wells.
- 3. Production from each zone to be commingled shall be separately measured by means of meters acceptable to the Commission. Production from Wells Nos. 3, 4 and 1-Abo, will be separately measured utilizing metering separators equipped with non-reset counters. These wells produce oil containing less than 1% BS&W. Production from Wells Nos. 5 and 1-Wolfcamp will be metered with positive volume meters equipped with non-reset counters. These wells are produced by hydraulic subsurface pumps and production from each is to be measured from the overflow of the individual wells power oil tank.

- 4. BS&W content will be periodically determined by the standard centrifugal testing procedures. Meters are to be proved monthly by means of a strapped storage tank.
- 5. The value of the commingled oil will be slightly higher than at present, as shown below:




A plat is attached hereto showing to the best of our knowledge and belief the location of the Baish "B" Lease, the wells thereon, those wells to be commingled, and offset wells and ownership thereof.

In view of the facts set out herein, it is respectfully requested that the Commission enter an order granting an exception to Rule 303 (a) to permit the commingling in common facilities of the commonly owned production from four pools produced from the Baish "B" Lease as described above.
