Re: Request for Administrative Approval to Commingle
Oil Production From the Vacuum Upper Pennsylvanian
Pool on the "GO" State "F" Lease, Sec. 36
T17S, R34E, Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

Tidewater Oil Company respectfully requests approval to commingle oil production from the Vacuum Upper Pennsylvanian on its "GO" State "F" lease in accordance with Rule 303(b) of the NMOCC Rules and Regulations.

In support of this application, Tidewater wishes to state the following:

1. Tidewater's "GO" State "F" lease is located in Section 36, T17S, R34E, Vacuum Multipay Pools, Lea County, New Mexico.

2. Tidewater is authorized to, and is presently commingling oil production from the Vacuum Glorieta, Blinbry, Abo and Wolfcamp in accordance with administrative order PC-147.

3. Getty Oil Company is the only working interest owner of this lease. Tidewater is operator.

4. Tidewater is currently drilling well No. 8 which has been approved by Administrative Order No. MC-1497 to produce oil from the Abo, Wolfcamp and Upper Pennsylvanian Pools.

5. Attached is a table listing the present gravities, values thereof, composite gravity, value thereof, daily volume (including expected top allowable volumes from the Abo and Wolfcamp zones in No. 8) and daily revenue increase or decrease together with the proposed composite gravity, value thereof, daily volume and daily revenue increase.

6. Attached is a diagrammatic sketch of the proposed installation, and a plat showing the location of all wells on this lease.

7. The expected commercial value of the proposed commingled production

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will be more than the present production (including expected production from the Abo and Wolfcamp in No. 8) by approximately \$25/day.

8. Tidewater has furnished the New Mexico Commissioner of Public Lands a copy of this application with a letter requesting approval to commingle.

9. Production from the Vacuum Upper Penn will be metered by a three-phase metering separator and sampled prior to commingling.


