Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of May 27, 1963, and our letter of June 10, 1963, regarding the commingling of Grayburg-Jackson and Fren production on your Federal Las Cruces 049998(a) Lease located in Section 17, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests. We have now received the consent of the United States Geological Survey to such commingling.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities"; and provided further, that you shall immediately notify the Commission at such time as any well in either pool is capable of top allowable production.
