The method of commingling as described in the application is hereby approved. You are requested to notify our Hobbs office when the installation is completed so that a field inspection of the system can be made.

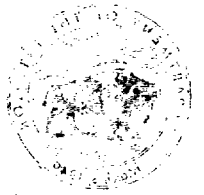
