Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated December 17, 1963, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Gladiola-Devonian and undesignated San Andres production on your Lois Wingard Lease comprising, in pertinent part, the E/2 NE/4 and SE/4 of Section 24, Township 12 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests. It is our understanding that all of the production from both of the aforesaid pools is of marginal nature.
