Dear Sir:

Socony Mobil Oil Company, Inc. respectfully requests the Commission rescind their commingle order No. PC-179 dated December 27, 1963 permitting commingling of the Paddock, Penrose-Skelly, and Eunice-San Andres production from Socony Mobil's E. O. Carson Well No. 5, Well No. 11, and Well No. 23.

At the time we requested the above commingling permission, we did not realize that permission has been granted by Order No. R-2079 dated October 9, 1961 and a letter dated January 19, 1962 to commingle the Paddock, Penrose Skelly, McCormack, and Eunice-San Andres production on the E. O. Carson lease. Permission was given to commingle all sour production on the basis of quarterly well tests except for E. O. Carson Well No. 23 (Eunice-San Andres) and E. O. Carson Well No. 20 (Paddock), which must be metered prior to commingling.
