Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of July 19, 1965, wherein you advise that your Argo A Well No. 9 was recently completed as a top allowable Wantz-Abo producer. Administrative Order PC-180 authorized the commingling of top allowable Blinebry production with marginal Drinkard and Wantz-Abo production on the Argo-Argo A Lease after separately metering the Blinebry production and the combined Drinkard Wantz-Abo marginal production.

Administrative Order PC-180 is hereby amended to permit the commingling of Blinebry, Drinkard, and Wantz-Abo production in accordance with the schematic diagram which you submitted with your letter of July 19, separately and continuously metering each of the three producing zones prior to commingling.
