Reference is made to your authorization to commingle the production from the Drinkard and Wantz-Abo Pools on our Gutman Lease comprising the NW/4SW/4 of Section 11, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, dated January 17, 1964, after separately metering the Wantz-Abo production and determining the Drinkard production by means of the subtraction method.

We now find that neither zone is top allowable and respectfully request administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the commission rules and regulations to permit commingling of Drinkard and Wantz-Abo production from our Gutman No. 1 and Gutman No. 2, at the aforesaid location, by allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests.
