Reference is made to your application dated January 30, 1964, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Drinkard and Blinebry production from your Sarkeys Lease comprising the SW/4 of Section 23, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Blinebry production and determining the Drinkard production by means of the subtraction method.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for a non-reset counter on the meter.
