
Gentlemen:

We are currently commingling Oil Center Blinbry and Grayburg San Andres production on our State "J" lease (Section 32, T-20-S, R-37-E), Lea County, New Mexico. Blinbry production is separately metered and Grayburg production is determined by the subtraction method.

At present all wells on the lease are marginal with no well capable of top allowable production. Therefore, we request permission to commingle production on the subject lease without separate metering. Allocation of production would be made on the basis of monthly well tests. The proposed change would allow us to retire some equipment from the lease for use in other operations.

In support of our request we are submitting a 60-day tabulation of production from each well. The installation will continue to be operated in accordance with the Commission's "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities".
