**Amendment
Administrative Order PC-192**

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of April 21, 1965, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-192 to permit the inclusion of Skaggs-Drinkard production in the commingling installation authorized by said order. Administrative Order PC-192 authorized the commingling of Skaggs and East Weir Tubb production in a common tank battery after separately metering the Tubb production and determining the Skaggs production by means of the subtraction method. It is our understanding that the Skaggs and Skaggs-Drinkard zones are both of marginal nature and that you will continue to separately meter the Tubb production, determining the combined Skaggs and Skaggs-Drinkard production by means of the subtraction method. Allocation to each of these two latter zones would be made on the basis of periodic well tests.

Administrative Order PC-192 is hereby amended as described above. Provided, however, that the installation shall continue to be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," and provided further, that you shall notify the Commission in the event that any well in either the Skaggs or Skaggs-Drinkard Pools becomes capable of top allowable production.
