Gentlemen:

Administrative Order PC-197, dated February 27, 1964, granted permission to commingle oil produced from the Vacuum Wolfcamp and Vacuum Glorieta Pools on our M. E. Hale Lease. The Hale Lease consists of the SE/4 and E/2 of the SW/4 of Section 35, T17S, R34E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Well No. 9 is currently being drilled and it is anticipated that the well will be completed in the Vacuum Wolfcamp, Vacuum Glorieta and Vacuum Abo Pools. Therefore, Phillips Petroleum Company respectfully requests that Administrative Order PC-197 be amended to include the Vacuum Abo Pool.

The Vacuum Abo has a gravity of 38° API and a top allowable of 187 BOPD. The gravity of the commingled stream will be 40° API. The value of the commingled stream will be equal to or greater than the values of the separate streams. The Abo and Glorieta production will be metered and the Wolfcamp will be obtained by the subtraction method.

The installation will be operated in accordance with NMOCC "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."

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The Commissioner of Public Lands, State of New Mexico, has been notified of this request.
