Gentlemen:

Reference is made to the Commission's letter dated June 24, 1964, amending Administrative Order PC-207 and authorizing Mobil Oil Corporation to commingle the Drinkard and Terry-Blinebry production on the subject lease after metering the Drinkard production and determining the Terry-Blinebry production by means of the subtraction method.

Mobil Oil Corporation respectfully requests that Administrative Order PC-207 be further amended so as to permit the commingling of production from the aforementioned pools by determining the production from each well and each pool by well tests conducted periodically as the Commission may prescribe. As shown on the attached tabulation of production for the months of December 1967 and January 1968, the average daily production for this period is considerably below top allowable for the subject pools.

Royalty ownership of all zones to be commingled is identical.
