Reference is made to your letter of June 2, 1964, in which you have requested approval to command production in the VACUUM ABO NORTH and VACUUM GLORIETA Pools in the subject lease.

Please be advised that Mobil Oil Company may proceed with this commingling project, with the approval of the New Mexico State Land Office. Upon completion of the installation of the common tankage equipment and accessories, but before they are put into operation, we should like to request that Mobil notify this office of the completion, so that an inspection of the installed equipment might be accomplished.
