Administrative Order PC-219

## Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated March 24, 1965, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-219 to include the Wantz-Abo production in the commingling authority contained therein. Administrative Order PC-219 authorizes Sinclair Oil & Gas Company to commingle Blinebry Oil Pool and Drinkard Pool production on its S. J. Sarkeys Lease comprising the SE/4 of Section 23, Township 21 South, Range 37 East after the Blinebry production has been metered and the Drinkard production determined by means of the subtraction method.

It is our understanding that the Wantz-Abo production is also top allowable and that you propose to separately meter Blinebry and Wantz-Abo production and determine the Drinkard production by means of the subtraction method.

Administrative Order PC-219 is hereby amended to include the Wantz-Abo production in the commingling authority contained therein, subject to continued operation in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
