Gentlemen:

Sinclair Oil & Gas Company currently commingles the oil production from the Blinebry Oil Pool and the Drinkard Pool under Administrative Order PC-219 on the S. J. Sarkeys lease in the SE/4 of Section 23, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. The Blinebry production is metered and the Drinkard production is determined by the subtraction method.

The S. J. Sarkeys Well No. h was recently completed in the Wantz Abo Pool as a top allowable producer. The well is scheduled to become a Blinebry-Drinkard-Abo oil-oil-triple completion.

It is requested that an exception to State wide Rule 303 be granted to permit commingling of the oil produced from the Blinebry Oil, the Drinkard and the Wantz Abo Pools on the S. J. Sarkeys lease by separate metering of the Blinebry and Abo oils and by determining the Drinkard production using the subtraction method.


The value of the crude oil mixture will be \$3.01 per barrel and will have a gravity of 41.3° API. All the zones have common royalty.
