Administrative Order FC-226

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated February 1, 1965, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order FC-226. This order, as amended, permits the commingling of Vacuum-Glorieta, North Vacuum-Abo, Vacuum-Wolfcamp, and Vacuum-Upper Fennsylvanian production on your State Warn A/c 1 Lease, comprising the NE/4 SW/4 and SE/4 NW/4 of Section 31, Township 17 South, Range 35 East, Vacuum Field, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Glorieta, Abo and Upper Pennsylvanian production and determining the Wolfcamp production by means of the subtraction method. It is our understanding that the Abo and Wolfcamp zones have now declined to a marginal status, and that you propose to meter the Glorieta and Upper Fennsylvanian production separately and determine the Wolfcamp and Abo production by means of the subtraction method, allocating the production to each of the latter two zones by means of periodic well tests.

Administrative Order £C-226 is hereby amended to permit the commingling of the aforesaid zones in the above-described manner, provided however, that the installation shall continue to be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." Please notify the Commission at such time as any well in either the Abo or Wolfcamp zone becomes capable of top allowable production.
