Gentlemen:

Sinclair Oil & Gas Company requests an exception to Statewide Rule 303 and administrative approval to permit commingling of oil produced from the Stuart "A" WN lease in the Justis Blinebry and Tubb-Drinkard Pools in Unit C, Section 14, T25S, R37E. Both zones are commonly owned and they are top allowable. Commingling is highly desirable in order to eliminate the construction of an additional battery on this 40-acre lease.

It is proposed to meter the Blinebry oil and to use the subtraction method to determine the oil production from the Tubb-Drinkard.

The gravity of the Blinebry oil is 37.6° API and is valued at \$2.91 per barrel. The gravity of the Tubb-Drinkard is 37.1° API and is valued at \$2.91 per barrel. The gravity of the crude mixture is expected to be 37.4° API with a value of \$2.91 per barrel.

An early approval of this application would be appreciated. If additional information is required, please advise.

Attached is a schematic diagram of the proposed installation and a well and battery location plat.


