Gentlemen:

Administrative Order PC-249 granted Continental Oil Company authority to commingle production on our SEMU Lease, Sections 13, 14, 15, 22, 23 and 24, T-205, R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico from the Monument Tubbs, Weir Blinebry, and Weir Drinkard pools, provided production from all of the pools be metered. At the time Administrative Order PC-249 was granted some of the wells in each of the pools on the Semu Lease were top allowable. The following tabulation of production from The Semu Lease shows none of the wells are top allowable and the tests listed indicate they are not capable of producing top allowable. Therefore, Continental Oil Company respectfully requests that Administrative Order PC-249 be amended to eliminate the necessity of metering production from the individual pools on the Semu Lease. Production will be allocated to each pool and well based on current Gas-Oil Ratio Surveys.
