Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated April 27, 1965, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Blinebry, Tubb-Drinkard, Fusselman, and Montoya production on your Kimberly WN Lease in Sections 23 and 24, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, Justis Field, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Blinebry and Fusselman production and determining the Montoya and Tubb Drinkard production by means of the subtraction method, allocating the production to each of the two latter pools on the basis of periodic well tests. It is our understanding that the Blinebry and Fusselman zones both have wells capable of producing top allowable but that all wells in the Montoya and Tubb Drinkard formations are of marginal nature.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters, and provided further that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well in the Montoya or Tubb Drinkard formation is capable of top allowable production.
