Reference is made to your application dated February 18, 1956, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Justis-Blinebry and Justis-Tubb Drinkard production on your R. L. Mosley Lease comprising the N/2 SE/4 of Section 34, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Tubb Drinkard production and determining the Blinebry production by means of the subtraction method.
