Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated December 22, 1965, for authority to commingle Chacra gas produced from your Jicarilla 30 Well No. 4 located in Unit F, Section 31, Township 25 North, Range 4 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, with the oil and gas produced from an undesignated Gallup Oil Pool by the same well after metering the Chacra gas with an orifice meter and using the same flow line to carry the commingled production to a three-phase heated separator at the tank battery. We have now received the consent of the United States Geological Survey to your proposal.

Inasmuch as all production from both zones is of marginal nature, your proposed method of commingling is hereby approved, provided that the orifice meter reading of the Chacra gas shall be deducted from the total gas sales meter reading to determine the Gallup gas production.
