
Dear Sir:

Harper Oil Company respectfully requests Administrative Approval to Commingle Oil Production from the Blinebry and Abo oil pools in its Sarkeys No. 2 located in Unit "H" of Section 26, T 21S, R37E of Lea County, New Mexico.

The API gravity of the Blinebry Oil is 42° and of the Abo Oil is 40.6. The price is \$3.01 per barrel for each of these gravities. Commingling of these oils will also result in a price of \$3.01 per barrel.

A schematic diagram of the proposed installation and a plot showing the lease and well location is attached. Shell Pipeline, Oil purchaser, has approved this installation and Commingling of the Blinebry and Abo Oil Pools.

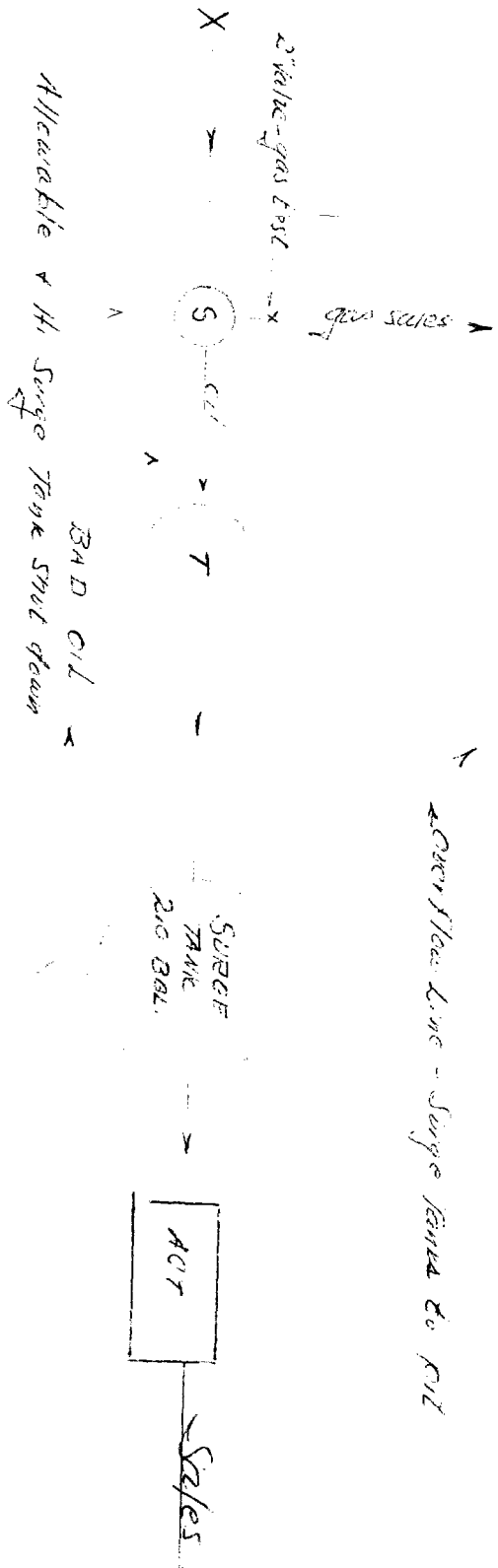


TANK Battery + ACT UNITS.

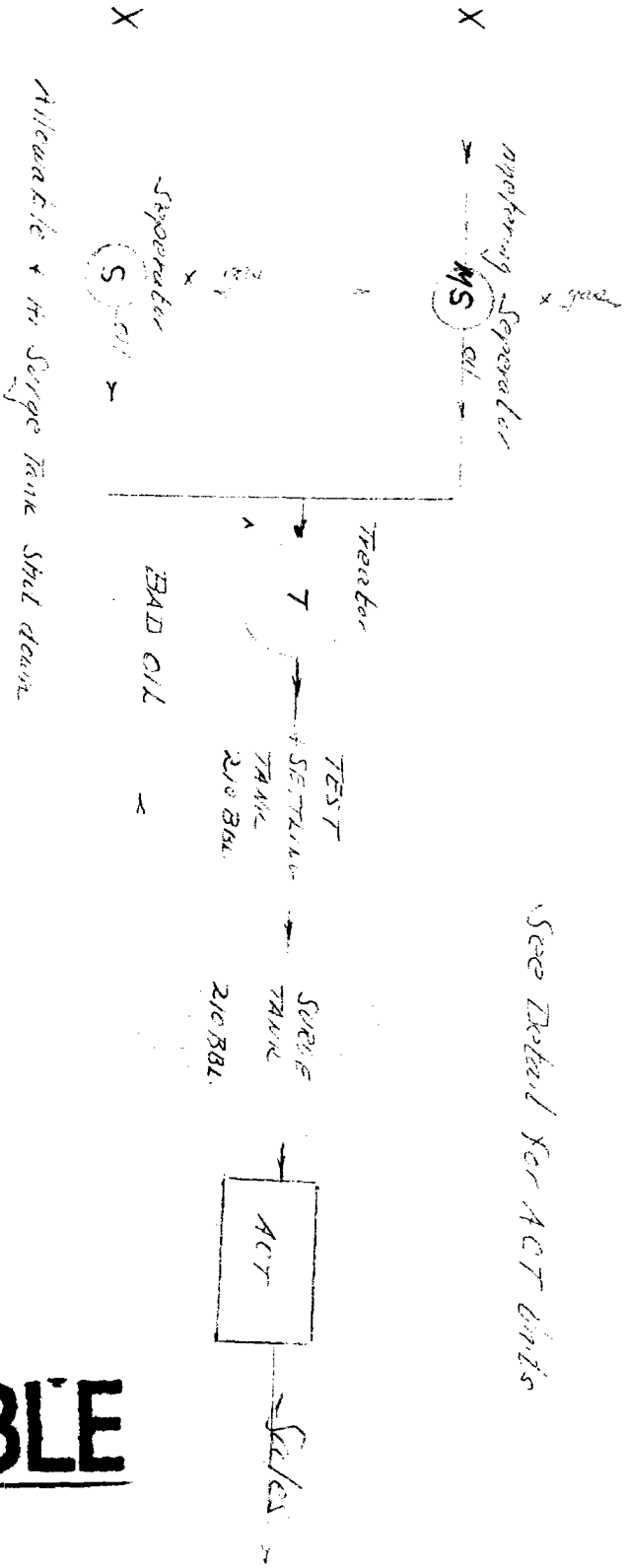
