TEXACO Inc. Leases Vacuum San Andres Pool Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

In accordance with New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rule 309-B, TEXACO Inc. hereby makes application for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A to permit the commingling of Vacuum San Andres Pool production on our leases in the Vacuum Pool, Lea County, New Mexico into a common tank battery located on the State of New Mexico "Z" Lease. In support of which is stated the following:

- 1. TEXACO Inc. is the operator of 25 leases as shown on the attached beneficiary code and working interest in the leases is common.
- 2. Production from the 25 leases is from the same common source of supply, Vacuum San Andres Pool.
- 3. Adequate facilities will be provided for accurately determining production from each well at reasonable intervals utilizing positive displacement meters as shown in the attached schematic diagram, Figure 1-A.
- 4. Adequate facilities will be provided for continuously determining production from each lease utilizing temperature compensating positive displacement meters and samplers as shown in the attached schematic diagram, Figure 1-A.

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- 5. A diversity in royalty ownership as shown in the attached beneficiary code exists between leases. Therefore, the production from each lease will be accurately measured prior to commingling into common gathering system as shown in the attached Plat No. 1.
- 6. Attached are letters of consent to commingling from the Commissioner of Public Lands, State of New Mexico, and from the Crude Oil Purchaser.

In view of the facts recited in this application, it is respectfully requested that administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A be granted TEXACO Inc. to permit commingling into a common tank battery Vacuum San Andres production from leases shown on attached beneficiary code and from all San Andres wells which may be completed in the Vacuum San Andres Pool on these leases in the future.



Gentlemen:

In accordance with New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rule 309-B TEXACO Inc. hereby makes application for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A to permit commissing operations to be conducted on the State of New Mexico "T" NCT-4 Lease. On December 8, 1961, the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission granted TEXACO Inc. administrative approval to commingle 25 leases in the Vacuum (San Andres) Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. At this time it is desirous to commingle the State of New Mexico "T" NCT-4 Lease with the aforementioned consolidated battery, in support of which is stated the following:

- 1. TEXACO is the operator of the State of New Mexico "T" Lease, consisting of 160 acres, being the NW/4 of Section 28, T-17-S, R-34-E, Lea County, New Nexico. Attached is a Plat showing the location of all wells on this lease and the pool from which they are producing.
- 2. The expected daily liquid hydrocarbon production from the State of New Mexico "T" NCT-4 Lease is 14 barrels of oil and that from the presently consolidated facility is approximately 2400 barrels of oil.
- 3. Working interest and royalty interest are common on all of the subject leases, however some of the leases have separate beneficiary accounts. These beneficiary accounts consist of Common School (C.S.) and Military Institute (M.I.). Permission

was granted previously to commingle leases having the same beneficiary based on production tests, then commingle the two beneficiary accounts together after properly metering each account by the use of temperature compensated P-D meters with non-reset counters and vapor-proof samplers. The State of New Mexico "T" NCT-4 Lease is a Common School beneficiary and it is proposed to commingle its production with the State of New Mexico "D" NCT-2 Lease which is also a Common School beneficiary, refer attached plat. The production will then be metered through the present installation at a point down stream where the MI and CS beneficiaries are commingled.

4. Royalty interest in the subject lease is common and is held in part by the State of New Mexico and a copy of this application is being sent this date to the State Land Office, Box 791, Santa Fe, New Mexico, requesting their approval in writing of the proposed installation. Immediately upon receipt of this approval, it will be forwarded to the Commission.

In view of the facts recited in this application, it is respectfully requested that administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A be granted TEXACO Inc. to permit commingling into a common tank battery liquid hydrocarbon production from the State of New Mexico "T" NCT-4 Lease and the previously commingled leases, in the Vacuum (San Andres) Pool and from all wells which may be completed in this reservoir on these leases in the future.



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


