Dear Sirs:

Effective August 1, 1967, the Windfohr Oil Company's Grayburg Jackson - San Andres Unit became effective. Included in the unit is the Jackson B well #21 in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 12, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. This well is now designated as Unit well #38. This well was previously designated in the Square Lake pool, but the flow line has now been changed, and the well is now producing into a battery with other wells in the Grayburg Jackson - San Andres Unit. All of the NE/4 of Section 12 - T 17S - R 30E should now be placed in the Grayburg Jackson pool instead of the Square Lake pool.

It is requested that authorization be given to Windfohr Oil Company to temporarily commingle oil from the Square Lake pool with the Grayburg Jackson pool as it pertains to Unit well #38.
