Re: Surface Commingling of Production from the State "DC" Lease.

Dear Sir:

A study has been completed to revise the battery and commingle the production from the State "DC" Lease. This lease is located in Sec. 19, T21S, R37E in Lea County, New Mexico.

Presently, the Drinkard and Blinebry zones are being commingled and the Paddock and Grayburg are being commingled. The proposal is to commingle all the production into one facility and allocate production on the basis of quarterly well tests. Royalty ownership is common. Approval has been received from the state of New Mexico Land Office and the transporter and purchaser.

Average gravities, volumes and values are as follows:

Selling the crudes more rapidily after commingling will decrease weathering time which will increase the volume and gravity. There will be less surface area for excess evaporation of "light ends" to occur. On the basis of 1% volume increase, the increase in gross income will be \$59 per month. After commingling, the operating and maintenance costs will be lowered, which will lower the economic limit and extend the producing life of the wells. Amerada Hess Corporation respectfully requests administrative approval to commingle the crudes on the State "DC" Lease and allocate production on the basis of quarterly well tests.




