Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated May 9, 1966, wherein you request authority to commingle Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres, Corbin Queen, and Corbin Abo production from your State BY, State CB, State CD, Ohio State A, and Cockburn State A Leases all in Section 32, Township 17 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool and each lease.
