**AMENDED COMMINGLING ORDER PC-796**

**LEASE NAME:** *South Mattix Unit Federal Lease*  
**DESCRIPTION:** *All of Section 15, NE/4, E/2 NW/4, E/2 SE/4, and NW/4 SE/4 of Section 22, Township 24 South, Range 37 East.*


The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle oil and gas production from the Fowler Fusselman, Fowler-Upper Yeso, Fowler-Upper Paddock, Fowler-Tubb, Fowler-Ellenburger and Fowler-Drinkard Pools in a common tank battery and in a common gas sales line and to determine the production from each pool by separately metering the production from each pool prior to commingling, with exception of the following:

Fusselman production from the South Mattix Federal "A" No. 5 and South Mattix Federal "B" No. 15 shall be separately metered at the satellite battery and then commingled with Upper Yeso production from the SMUF Well Nos. 3, 12, 13, 18, 19, 23, 30, 32 and 34. This commingled stream shall be transported to and metered at the central tank battery. Upper Yeso monthly production shall be determined by subtracting the total sales volume from the metered Fusselman volume.

Fowler-Tubb and Fowler-Upper Paddock production shall be determined by monthly well tests.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.
