Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated September 29, 1955 to dual and form a 120-acre non-standard gas proration unit on your Lockhart "A-35" Well No. 1 in the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 35, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. You failed to notify E. F. Moran, Inc. of your application and I called Mr. R. L. Adams of your Roswell office in regard to notifying Moran.

We received a letter from Mr. E. F. Moran dated October 13, 1955 in which he approved your application to dual subject well. However, he said, "Continental has advised us that they will unitize with us and are preparing contracts for same". Apparently Moran did not agree to your forming the 120-acre unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool and is expecting to communitize his 40 acres (SW/4 NW/4) to form a standard 160-acre unit. If so, do you desire to drop your request for an NSP Order? We will hold NSP-199 that was due to be issued on November 5, 1955 and await an answer from you.

A P P L I C A T I O N

Comes now CONTINENTAL OIL COMPANY, a Delaware Corpora-
tion, hereinafter called "Applicant" and respectfully requests
the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico to
issue an order authorizing Applicant to dually complete and allo-
cate a non-standard proration unit to its Lockhart A-35 No. 1
well, located 660 feet from the North line and 660 feet from
the West line of Section 35, T. 21S, R. 37E, N.M.P.M., Lea County,
New Mexico, in the Drinkard Oil Pool and the Blinebry Gas Pool,
and in support thereof would show the following:

The proposed gas unit contains 120 acres consisting
of contiguous quarter quarter sections, N/2 NW/4 and SE/4 NW/4
Section 35-21S-37E, lies wholly within a single governmental
section, and may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.

The dual completion of said well in the Drinkard for
oil and the Blinebry for gas is in the interest of conservation
and the protection of correlative rights.

Segregation of the producing intervals will be made
by appropriate packer installation and said well will be equipped
so there can be no comingling of well fluids in producing the
gas through the annulus between the tubing and casing, and the
oil through the tubing. Said well will be equipped in such a
manner that reservoir pressures may be determined separately for
each of the two specified pools and the well head equipment to
be equipped with all necessary connections to permit accurate
measurement of any natural gas, oil, or oil and gas produced from
each separate pool as may be required by the Commission.

Attached to this application is a plat showing the
location of said well and surrounding wells and leaseholds with

the acreage to be assigned the proposed gas unit outlined in red, a plat showing the mechanical condition of said well at present and after the proposed dual completion.

All offset operators have been duly notified by copy of this application.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico enter its orders authorizing Applicant to dually complete said well and allocate a non-standard proration unit to the well in accordance with the foregoing application and rules and regulations of the Commission.

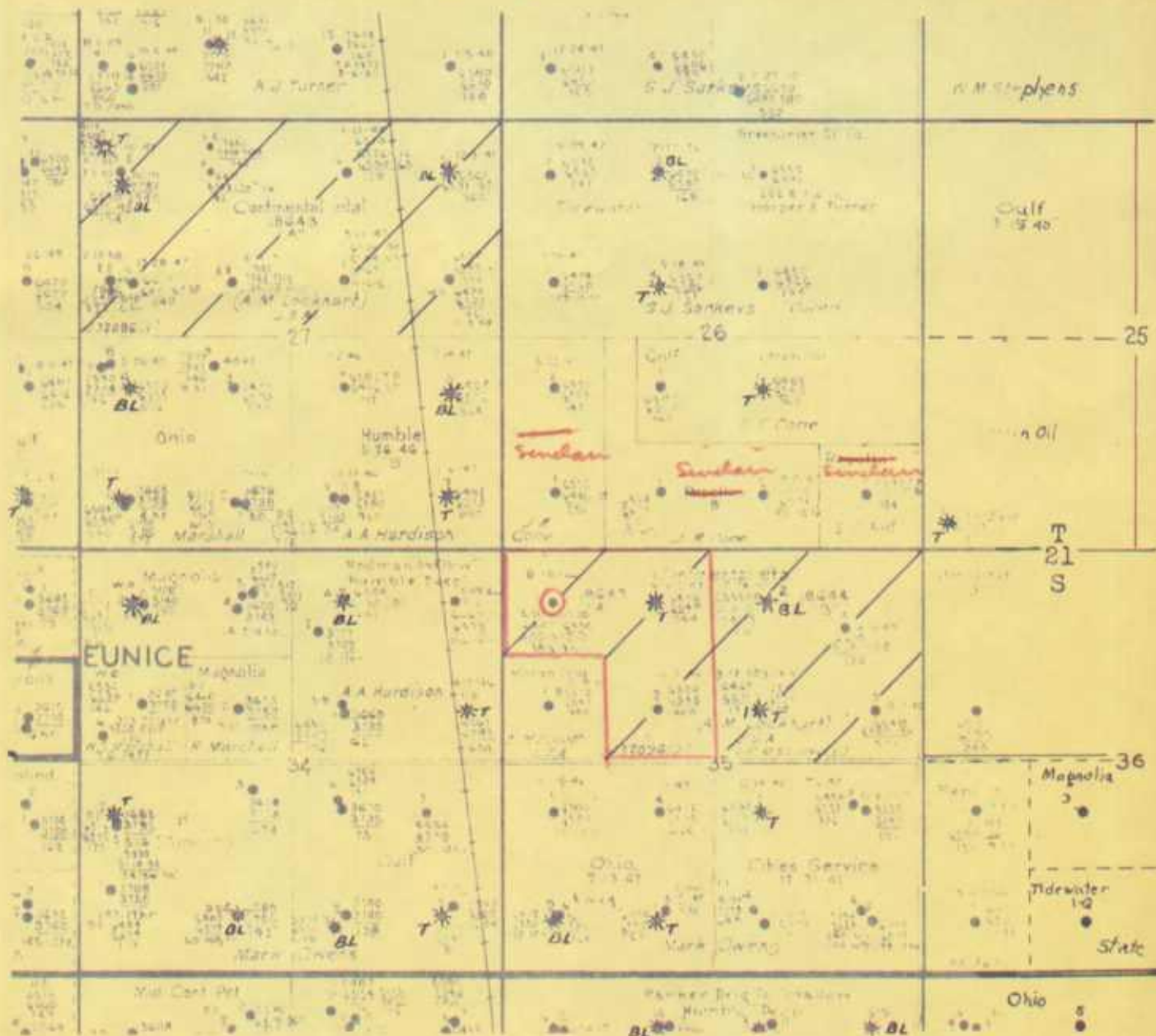
