Reference is made to your application for approval of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMPM SW/4 NE/4, SE/4 NW/4, NE/4 SW/4 and NW/4 SE/4 of Section 6

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your Wells Well No. 1, located 1980 feet from the north and east lines and in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 6, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.
