DC-296 to dually complete the Bay USA No. 2, located 1980' FNEW lines and in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 35, T-20-S, R-36-E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Eumont Gas Pool.

No. NSP-262 to form a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool, which consists of the NW/4 of Section 35, T-20-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The Bay USA No. 2 was originally completed in the Queens Oil Zone. In 1956, Tennessee Gas Transmission Company attempted a dual completion in the Eumont Gas Zone and the Queens Oil Zone. The Eumont Gas Zone was found to be nonproductive. The two zones were separated with a Brown BP-4 Bridging Plug Packer and the well was placed back on production, producing from the Queens Zone only. Since 1956, the well has continued to produce from the Queens Oil Zone.

Tennessee Gas Transmission Company plans to remove the packer and produce the well with the Eumont Gas Zone and the Queens Oil Zone open together. Commission Order No. R-520 states that the vertical limits of the Eumont Gas Pool shall extend from the top of the Yates Formation to the base of the Queens Formation, thereby including all of the Yates Seven Rivers and Queens Formations.
