Reference is made to your application for approval of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your B. V. Culp "B" Well No. 1, located 2310 feet from the South and East lines and in the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 31, Township 19 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 160 acres, after successful communitization.
