Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for a 200-acre non-standard proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Jalmat Gas Pool:


Lea County, New Mexico  
Township 25 South, Range 37 East  
Section 5: SE/4 and SE/4 SW/4

It is my understanding that this unit is to be simultaneously dedicated to your Wells Federal No. 1 located 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line and your Wells Federal No. 17 located at an unorthodox location 1980 feet the South line and 1450 feet from the East line of said Section 5 hereby approved under provisions of Rule 3 of Order No. R-1670.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 5 (C) 3 of Order No. R-1670, the above non-standard proration unit is hereby approved.

It should be noted that NSP-400 has been amended to simultaneously dedicate Wells Federal No. 17, drilled at an unorthodox location, and the existing well to the said proration unit.



Gentlemen:

In the near future, we plan to file a 9-331C and C-102 with the Bureau of Land Management District Office in Carlsbad for permission to drill a new Jalmat gas well as a Section 103 infill well at a non-standard location consisting of 1980' FSL and 1450' FEL Section 5, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The Wells Federal No. 17 must necessarily be drilled at an unorthodox location because the proration unit is criss-crossed by numerous powerlines, high pressure gas lines, and flowlines. The sketch attached to this letter shows the various obstacles in detail.

The subject well will be drilled on an existing 200-acre non-standard Jalmat (Gas) proration unit comprised of the SE/4 & SE/4 SW/4 Section 5 (NSP-400). At the present, the subject 200-acre tract is dedicated to the El Paso Natural Gas Company-operated (soon to be Doyle Hartman-operated) Wells Federal No. 1 (I-5-25S-37E) which is a Jalmat (Gas) producer, and upon the drilling and completion of the newly proposed Wells Federal No. 17, both the Wells Federal No. 1 and the Wells Federal No. 17 will be simultaneously dedicated to the existing 200-acre proration unit consisting of the SE/4 & SE/4 SW/4 Section 5.

Therefore, we hereby file for administrative approval to simultaneously dedicate the new infill well (Wells Federal No. 17) along with the Wells Federal No. 1 to the existing 200-acre non-standard Jalmat (Gas)

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proration unit comprised of the SE/4 & SE/4 SW/4 Section 5, T-25-S,  
R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Furthermore, if the proposed well is completed as a commercial producer and in compliance with the Natural Gas Policy of 1978, an application will also be submitted to the Bureau of Land Management to obtain administrative approval for the well as a Section 103 infill well.

Three copies of a land plat showing the location of the original Jalmat (Gas) well on the 200-acre proration unit plus the non-standard location of the proposed new infill well are also enclosed.

Copies of the enclosed application have also been sent by certified mail to all offsetting parties owning Jalmat Gas rights. The following is a list of the two offsetting Jalmat Gas owners:
