Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 240-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 20 South, Range 36 East, NMPN
Section 11: SE/4 and S/2 of SW/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Sanderson A-11 Well 4, located 990 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the East line of said Section 11 rather than your Sanderson A-11 Well No. 1, located 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line of said Section 11 as authorized by Order R-990 dated May 10, 1957.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5 (b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 240 acres.
