Gentlemen:

Humble Oil & Refining Company respectfully requests Administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit of 320 acres in the Eumont Gas Pool, being the S/2 of Section 9, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. This unit is to be assigned to Humble's J. L. Greenwood Well No. 5, located 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line of Section 9. A non-standard unit of 120 acres, being the N/2 of the S/2, is presently assigned to this well. In support of this request, we submit the following information:

1. J. L. Greenwood Well No. 5 was approved for a 160 acre non-standard gas proration unit by Administrative Order NSP-432 of June 5, 1958.
2. The proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
3. The non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
4. The entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
5. The length or width of the non-standard gas proration unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
6. All operators owning interests in this section and offset operators have been furnished copies of this application by Certified Mail.



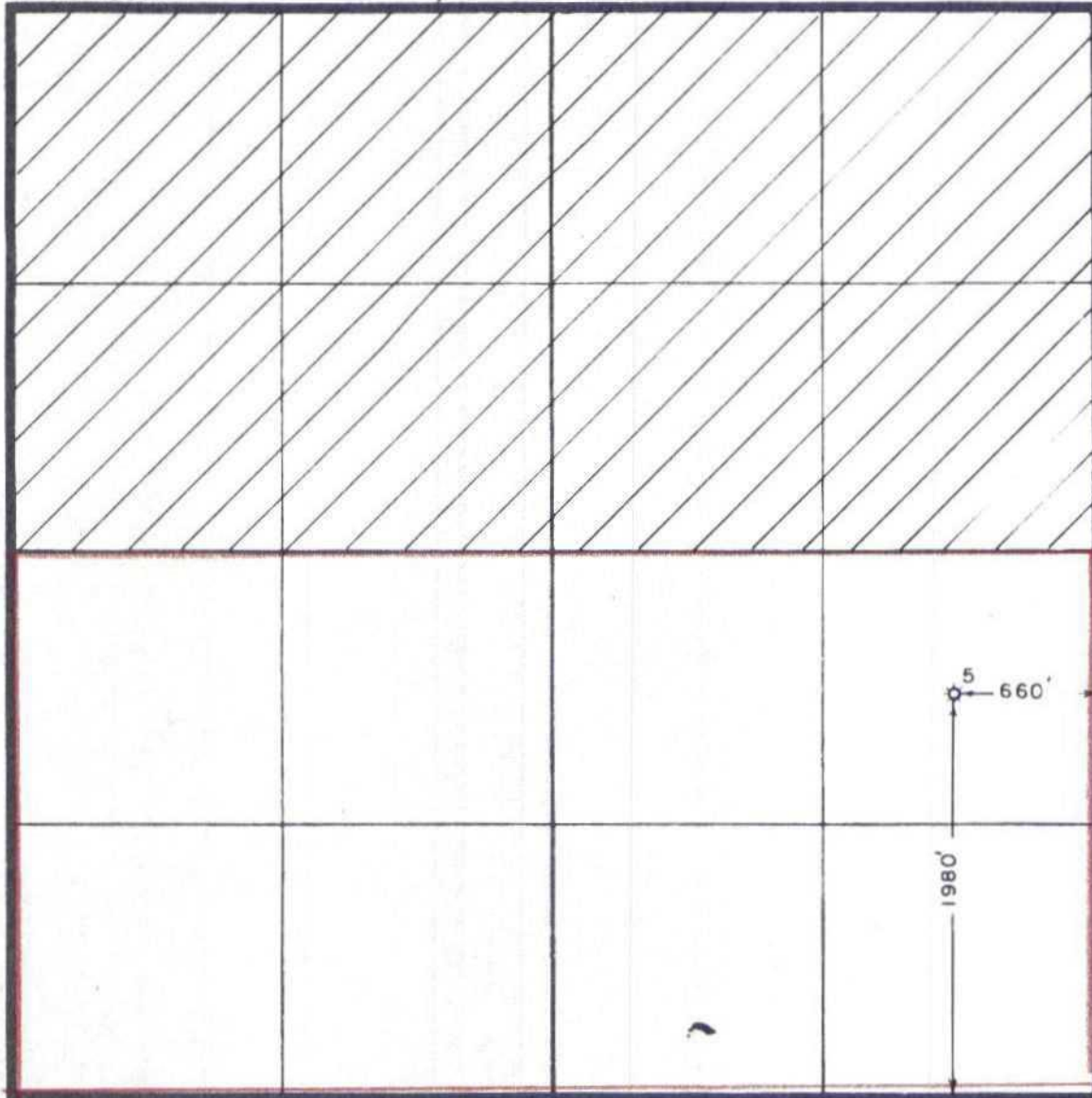

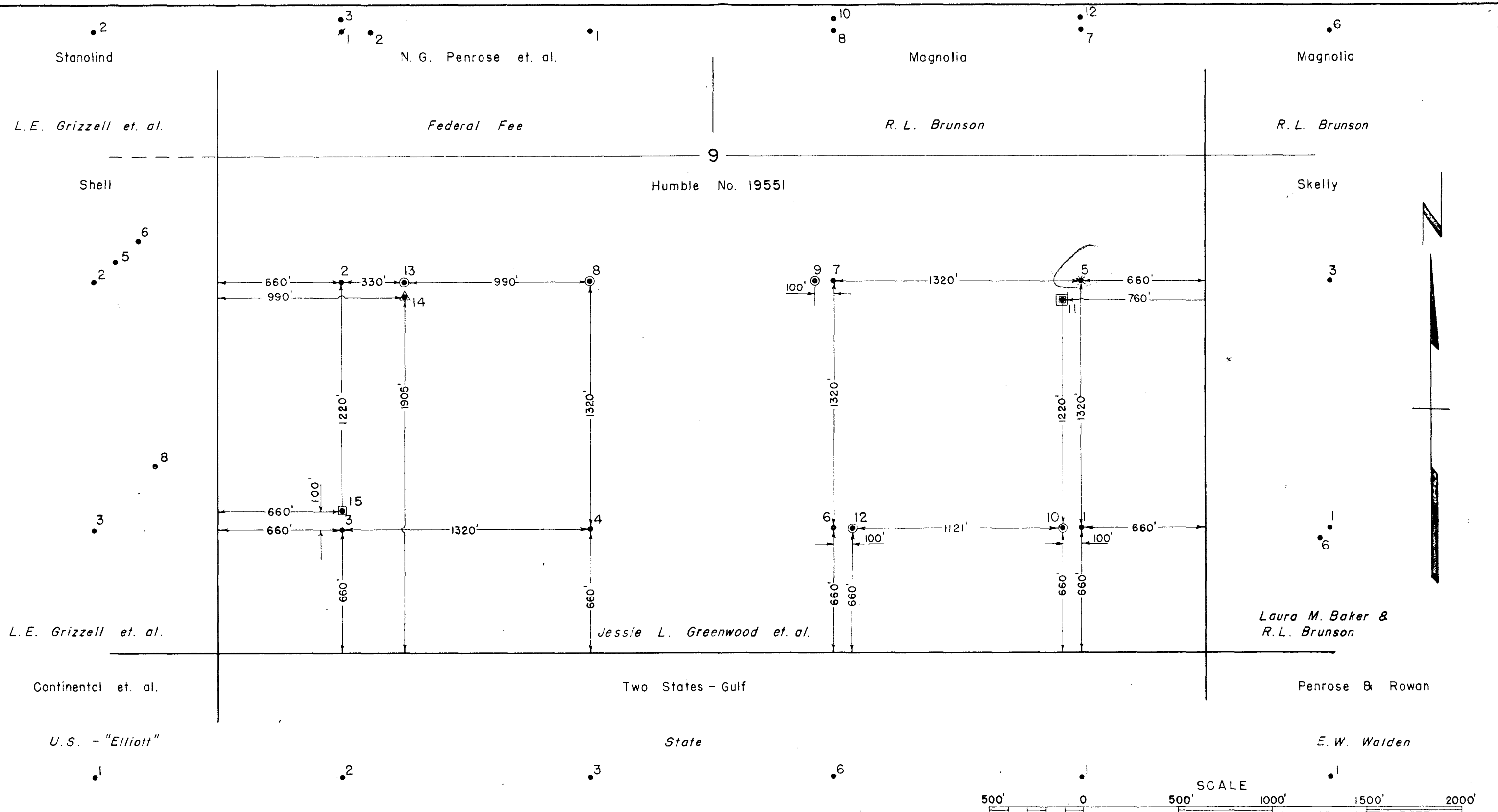
