Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 79-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Tubb Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM  
Section 33: S/2 NE/4 with the exception of one acre  
in the extreme SE/4 corner of said S/2 NE/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your J. N. Carson Well No. 2, located 2175 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the East line of said Section 33.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5 (d), of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Tubb Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-586, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 79 acres.
