Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an 80-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM
Section 10: E/2 SE/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your A. B. Baker Well No. 3, located 589 feet from the East line and 2051 feet from the South line of said Section 10.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5 (B), of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blinebry Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-610, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 80 acres.
