Re: Continental Oil Company's (Lapplication for reduction in size of the 640 acre gas unit assigned to Lynn B-26 No. 1 to a 320 acre unit consisting of the S/2 of Section 26: and reassignment of the 320 acres in N/2 to Lynn B-26 No. 3 in Section 26, T-23S, R-36E, NMPM, Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Gentlemen:

Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5 (b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool of Order No. R-520, for a reduction of the presently approved 640-acre gas unit assigned to the Lynn B-26 No. 1 to a 320 acre non-standard gas proration unit to consist of the S/2 of Section 26, T-23S, R-36E: and for the reassignment of the 320 acres comprising the N/2 of the said Section 26 for the formation of a 320 acre nonstandard gas proration unit to be allocated to the Lynn B-26 No. 3 well located 990' from the North line and 1650' from the West line of said Section 26.

In support of this request we should like to point out that the proposed gas units conform with the requirements of said Rule 5 (b) in all respects as follows:

- Said proposed non-standard gas proration units consist of continguous quarter-quarter sections.
- 2. Said proposed non-standard gas proration units lie wholly within a single governmental section.
- 3. The entire proposed non-standard gas proration units may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.

- 4. The length or width of said units do not exceed 5,280 feet.
- 5. Copies of this application have been furnished this date by registered mail to all offset operators and all operators within 1,500 feet of said well, as required by the provisions of said Rule 5 (b).

A plat is attached hereto showing the proposed units, the location of the Nos. 1 and 3 wells and other wells on the lease, offset wells and ownership thereof.

The granting of this application is in the interest of preventing waste and the protection of correlative rights.

In view of the facts set out herein it is respectfully requested that the Commission enter an order approving the non-standard gas proration unit for Continental Oil Company's Lynn B-26 Nos. 1 and 3 wells as described above.


