Gentlemen:

Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval for the expansion of the 240-acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the SF/4 and the S/2 of the NE/4 of Section 14, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, assigned to its SEMU Permian well No. 46 located 1980 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the east line of Section 14, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Eumont Gas Pool, to include the NW/4 of the NE/40of Section 14, Township 20 South, Range 37 East.

- In support of this request we should like to point out that the proposed 286-acre unit conforms with the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Cas Pool of Order No. R-520 in all respects as follows:
- 1. Said proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
- 2. Said proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- 3. The entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.
 - 4. The length or width of said unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
- 5. Copies of this application have been furnished this date by registered mail to all offset operators and all operators within 1,500 feet of said well, as required by the provisions of said Rule 5(b).

A plat is attached hereto showing to the best of our knowledge and belief the present and proposed unit, the location of the No. 46 well and other wells on the lease, offset wells and ownership thereof.

The granting of this application is in the interest of preventing waste and the protection of correlative rights.

In view of the facts set out herein it is respectfully requested that the Commission enter an order approving the expansion of the present non-standard gas proration unit by 40 acres for Continental Oil Company's SFMU Permian No. well No. 46 as described above.


