Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 308-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM
Section 30: W/2

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Closson "B" Well No. 10, located 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line of said Section 30.

By authority granted me under provisions of Order No. R-1670, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 308 acres.

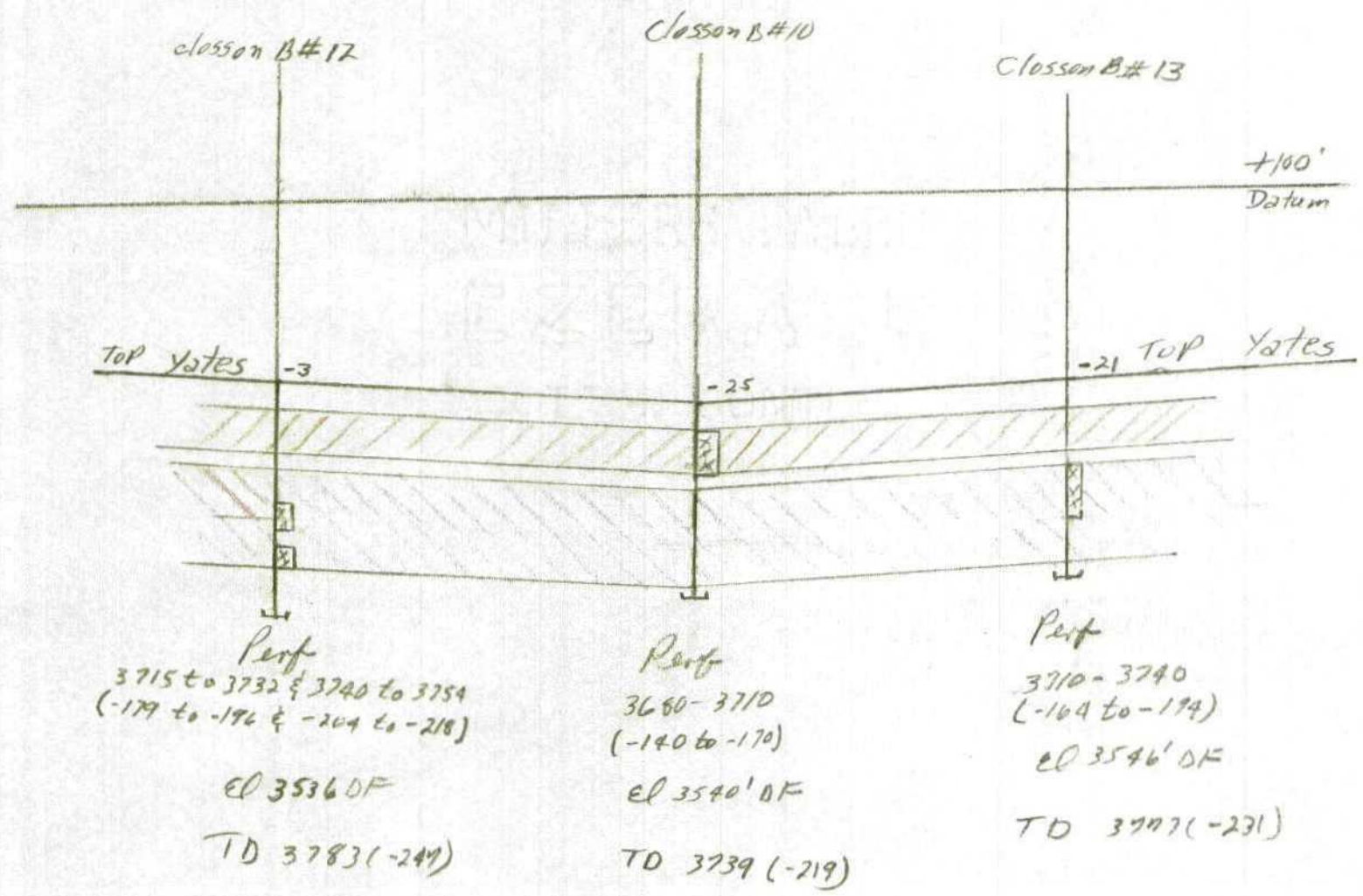
OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

The base of Perforations in well #10 is completed some 10' higher geologically than the top of the perf. in well #13, and some 30' higher than the top of the perf. in well #12, as shown on accompanying stick log xsection. The Gas well #10 is not in true dual dedication with wells #12 & #13., and I recommend that the N.S.P. be granted.


Gentlemen:

By letter dated December 22, 1960, Cities Service Oil Company filed application for the designation of a 308 acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County. The non-standard unit consisting of the West half of Section 30, T-22-S, R-36-E, is to be assigned to Closson "B" Well No. 10.

According to the plat attached to the Cities Service application, two other wells are located on the non-standard unit - Closson "B" No. 12 and Closson "B" No. 13. On the oil proration schedule, both these wells are assigned allowables as oil wells producing within the defined limits of the Jalmat Gas Pool. Order No. R-1670, Rule 29 prohibits simultaneous dedication of acreage to both a gas well and an oil well in the Jalmat Gas Pool.

These apparent facts are presented only for your information, and are not intended as an objection to the granting of the Cities Service application since an objection is unnecessary if the information is correct. Reaho Corporation does not object to the formation of a non-standard proration unit consisting of all or any part of the West half of Section 30-22S-36E provided it is formed in accord with the applicable rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.
