It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your State "A" A/c-2 Well No. 8, located 660 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line of said Section 7.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-1670, as amended, governing the Jalmat Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 160 acres.
