## Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an SO-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO <u>TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM</u> Section 3: Lote 6 and 11

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Shell Taylor-Glenn Well No. 1, located 1980 feet from the West line and 3226 feet from the North line of said Section 3.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-1670, as amended, governing the Blinebry Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 80 acres.

The 160-acre proration unit dedicated to your Shell Taylor-Glenn Well No. 1 shall be decreased to a 120-acre non-standard proration unit effective the date an oil well allowable was assigned to the first oil

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well completed on the 160-acre unit. The 80-acre non-standard proration unit approved by this order shall be effective the date an oil well allowable was assigned to the second oil well completed on the 160-acre unit.
