Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 40-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM
Section 12: NW/4 NW/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Skaggs B-12 Well No. 2, located 660 feet from the North line and 610 feet from the West line of said Section 12.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-1670, as amended, governing the Eumont Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 40 acres.
